A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SEDGWICK, COLORADO APPROVING ALLOCATING ITS REMAINING CARES ACT FUNDING TO THE TO BE CREATED SEDGWICK COUNTY BUSINESS GRANT TO HELP ADVERSELY EFFECTED BUSINESSES IN SEDGWICK COUNTY DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes (“C.R.S.”) § 31-15-101 et seq., the Board of Trustees of the Town of Sedgwick, Colorado (the “Board”) is authorized to adopt and enforce ordinances and resolutions regarding health, safety, and welfare issues as otherwise proscribed by law.

WHEREAS, the Town agrees that allowing for its remaining CARES funding to be used for adversely effected business in Sedgwick County is in accordance with C.R.S. § 31-15-101.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTESS OF THE TOWN OF SEDGWICK, COLORADO, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY THAT:

The Sedgwick Board of Trustees approves allocating its remaining CARES Act Funding to Sedgwick County, to create Sedgwick County Business Grant Program, to help adversely effected businesses in Sedgwick County due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
